

## Newton Europe Summit 11 July 2019

<b>Key Issues / Themes / Messages</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. This programme looks both hospital discharge decision making and A&amp;E admissions as wider NHS and local authority system predominantly using data to find solutions. Initial work was funded nationally – Leeds CCG has made the decision to invite the Newton to Europe team back paying for them this time to look at progress from 2018 and some further work around the front door (admission decisions)</li><li>2. Achievements to date including stroke pathway which has reduced the length of stay by 45% from 34 to 18 days; no MH patients are now waiting for funding decisions for mental health; 25% increase in discharges before 4 pm from wards which has a positive impact in terms of people returning home safely and supported and the pace of social work picking up cases improved</li><li>3. People's awareness seems to have changed but not behavior</li><li>4. Some of the issues that emerged were decision-makers in A&amp;E not trusting the timelines or lacking information through what the community (mainly focused on health and care but also applies to 3<sup>rd</sup> sector) provides</li></ol>
