Who will it help?

The Windrush Community Fund seeks to encourage more people to access the government Windrush schemes. The schemes help people get the documents they need to prove their right to live and work in the UK, and to claim compensation if they suffered losses and impacts, such as not being able to work or get healthcare.

What does it involve?

The fund will provide grants of up to £25,000 to community and grassroots organisations who can produce engaging communications programmes to raise awareness of the Windrush schemes. Activities might include:

- Holding promotional and outreach events
- Producing and distributing marketing materials
- Accessing and using communication channels
- Securing support from corporate partners, public or prominent figures or advocates

How to apply

Applications are welcomed from organisations who wish to promote these schemes to all those eligible to apply, from all communities and nationalities. We also welcome applications from organisations who have links with communities overseas.

The closing date for phase 1 applications is 12 February 2021. Phase 2 will open for applications on 1 April 2021 and will close on 30 June 2021.
