The Tablets project run by Barca-Leeds, the Orion Manbassador project and Unlocked magazine have reached the end of their funding and have come to a stop - for now, at least!



But not before:

- Barca-Leeds had delivered ONE HUNDRED tablets to isolated men in just two months
- Orion distributed around 25,000 magazines containing info, education and entertainment to men all over Leeds
- Touchstone set up online support groups with 60 men joining in just 3 months.


Meanwhile, MHU carries on! For example:
